
## RUDOLF PAUL RENFER

Artist, Rudolf Paul Renfer was born in Lengnau and today lives in Olten, Switzerland. A largely self-taught artist, further training at New Art School Zurich, has provided him with new perspectives. Renfer has participated in exhibits in Switzerland and abroad and is currently immersed in a phase with work that deals with figurative motifs and abstract pictorial spaces, which two elements he considers to connect in a unique way. In Renfer's work action is centered on the background. His wide horizons provided a sophisticated play of light and dark that functions as a pathway, leading the viewer's eye deep into the pictorial space. Renfer's work are psychological and focus on the human experience, feelings and the struggle of inventing and pursuing one's identity. His unique canvases captivate the viewer and provide with a beautiful terrain for thought and reflection.
